A local college-radio legend will broadcast his 1,000th show, a remarkable career in a notoriously fickle business.

Tom Gagliardi has played progressive-rock classics from Genesis to Yes to Emerson, Lake & Palmer since 1991 and has interviewed such prog-rock giants as keyboardist Tony Banks (Genesis) and composer Jan Hammer. His show, which usually airs Saturday from 10 p.m. to 2 a.m. on WBZC-FM (88.9) out of Burlington County College, has been honored by the National Association of College Broadcasting (1995).

His 1,000th show will be an eight-hour special starting at 6 p.m. Saturday with selections from his "Gagliarchives" and recollections from his 16 years on the air.
